1ST – 2ND WRITING

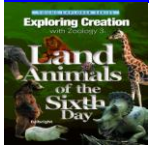
CURRICULUM: "DRAW WRITE NOW"

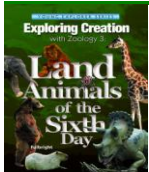

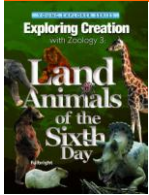
