**CURRICULUM:** *Draw Write Now*

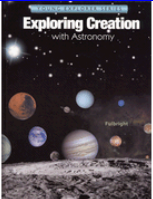

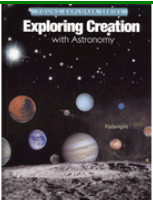

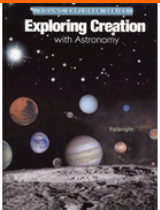
